## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING THE UTHSC ON BEHALF OF ITS COLLEGE OF MEDICINE CHATTANOOGA AND THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE AT CHATTANOOGA UNIVERSITY HEALTH SERVICES

Medical Students and Physician Assistant Students enrolled at the University of Tennessee Health Science Center ("UTHSC") require access to University Health services while on rotation at the UT College of Medicine Chattanooga (primarily based at Erlanger Health System in Chattanooga) and away from the main medical school campus located in Memphis, Tennessee.

The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga University Health Services (UTC UHS) will provide services to these students from the UT Health Sciences Center (UTHSC) during hours of normal business operation: Monday through Friday, 8 AM - 5 PM ET. Appointments may be made by calling UHS at 423.425.2266. UTHSC students should bring their UT ID and insurance card to each visit. If a student is unable to arrive for an appointment, cancellations should be made within six hours of the appointment. For non-urgent issues, appointments are usually available within 48 hours of a call.

UHS is not open during evening or weekend hours and does not provide emergency service during those times. If an emergency arises when UHS is closed, the student will need to contact 911 or go to the nearest Emergency Department (Erlanger Health System, CHI Memorial Hospital, or HCA Parkridge Medical Center), Urgent Care or walk-in clinics. Costs are the responsibility of the student.

UTHSC will pay the \$25.00 provider access fee to the UTC University Health Services, and the UTHSC students will not be assessed this charge. Payment will be processed by internal transfer from UT Account# E074405.

UTC University Health Services provided to its students and those of the UTHSC students assigned in Chattanooga are detailed on the attached page with pricing. Routine University Health Services include the following (costs are associated with some services):

- Treatment of acute illnesses
- Womens's Health and Men's Health exams
- Physical exams (excluding NCAA sports physicals)
- Sexually Transmitted Infections evaluations
- Select immunizations
- Allergy shots
- Basic Laboratory Tests, Radiologic Tests, and Specialty Imaging as ordered by UHS Providers

Students must provide insurance information at the time of service for any possible referrals or lab work. UTC University Health Services does not bill the student's health insurance but the student can submit a claim form for reimbursement with his/her insurer if a fee is charged other than the \$25 access fee covered by UTHSC. <u>Click here</u> to access the UT University Health Insurance Claim form. In the event a clinic visit requires a physical exam, labs, or any additional testing or services, the patient may incur charges and is expected to pay for any charges on the day the services are provided. Fees charged are based on the cost to the University Health Services facility. UHS accepts cash, check, Visa, American Express, or Master Card. Any change in fees for service will be communicated to UTHSC prior to renewal of the contract.

Blood borne pathogen exposures/evaluations and treatment are not available at the UTC University Health Services. If a student has an exposure, the student may be seen during daytime working hours by Erlanger ExpressCare or the Erlanger Emergency Department if the exposure is after hours or on holidays or weekends. Follow-up would be at Erlanger ExpressCare or as otherwise directed with the bill being sent to the UT Health Science Center for processing. Erlanger ExpressCare can also provide TB skin tests and mask fit tests for a small fee to the student.

COVID testing is available to UTHSC students via the Clinica Medicos Clinic (423.760.4000). COVID vaccines are available to UTHSC students via the Hamilton County Health Department locations (423.209.8383).

In the event that UHS is closed, UTHSC students may contact the Erlanger Academic Internal Medicine (AIM) office (423.778.8179) to schedule an appointment. Insurance will be billed by AIM and co-pays or balances would be the student's responsibility.

UTHSC students also have access to the UTHSC UHS in Memphis via telehealth and to virtual counseling via the SASSI counselors in Memphis (901.541.5654) or UTHSC After Hours Counseling Line (901.690.2273). Other free, confidential counseling services for students are available through the ENI NexGen Total Well-Being Program (800.327.2555) and the LifeBridge Chattanooga Program (423.591.9830).

This agreement is effective as of July 1, 2021 and will renew annually in July each year by mutual agreement until otherwise notified.

This agreement may be cancelled by providing sixty days written notice by either party.
