Thanks again to our extraordinary employees as we have been named a 2016 Top Workplace by the Commercial Appeal in Memphis. This is the third year in a row that we have been recognized as an employer of choice. Each year, the Commercial Appeal contracts with national survey vendor, Workplace Dynamics to poll employees in the Memphis area. The survey contains 22 questions that deal with demographic data, engagement, alignment, effectiveness, connection, and supervision. Our participation rate for 2016 was 46% (2002 employees) with more than 2500 individual comments. The survey results have been shared with the Deans and Vice Chancellors.

The campus plan this year is to focus on the departments that gave specific feedback and shared areas of concern related to the items assessed in the survey. The campus leadership will meet directly with employees and managers to assess and address critical items. These forums will take place quarterly in 2017.
