### DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE UTHSC CAMPUS

From Interstate 240, exit Union Avenue west bound. Turn right on Pauline at the first traffic light; turn left at the traffic light on Court Avenue and left at the parking garage. You are just east of the 910 Madison Avenue Building where you will meet for the morning orientation. [Proceed to the gate to retrieve your parking ticket] From Interstate 40, proceed west and exit Madison Avenue. Pass through the first traffic light at Pauline; turn right at the second light on Dudley. [Proceed to the gate to retrieve your parking ticket] From downtown, take Madison Avenue East, approximately nine (9) blocks, turn left at the traffic light on Pauline; turn left at the traffic light on Court Avenue and left at the parking garage. [Proceed to the gate to retrieve your parking ticket]

### A TYPICAL INTERVIEW DAY

A typical interview day begins at 8:00 a.m. ending around 4:00 p.m. Upon arriving, interviewees are given an informational packet. The Assistant Dean for Admissions and Student Affairs provides general instructions for the day and brief introductory remarks. The Medicine Admissions Office provides light refreshments. Interviewees and Committee members are scheduled to meet throughout the day for personal interviews. **Two one-on-one interviews are conducted with members of the Committee on Admissions and may include regional members located in various parts of the state.** Interview appointments typically range from a minimum of thirty minutes to an hour. **Be prepared to do a lot of walking. Bring or wear comfortable walking shoes.**

During the time between interviews, optional activities are made available for interviewees to attend freshman and sophomore classes, speak with a Financial Aid Counselor and/or visit the Health Sciences library. At 11:15 a.m., sophomore students are available to answer questions and conduct a tour of the General Education Building where classes are held. After the GEB tour, sophomore, junior and senior medical students will have lunch with interviewees, answer additional questions and conduct a tour of the clinical facilities. After the tour of the clinical facilities, interviewees will meet with the Assistant Dean for Admissions and Student Affairs who will explain the process of selection, when notification may be received and to answer questions. If you are not scheduled for afternoon interview appointments, you will have the option to sit in on a class or you will be done for the day, after the wrap-up session.

### FREE PARKING

Free parking will be made available for you to park in the "H" lot on the day of your interview in Memphis. "H" lot is located at the corner of Madison and Dudley, or you may enter at Pauline and Court. [See UTHSC campus directions] Before you enter the "H" parking lot, you will be prompted to obtain a ticket from the ticket box. Your ticket will be validated during the morning session. [Validation will not be available with any other campus parking area other than "H"]

### OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATIONS

If you should need overnight accommodations, special rates may be available for you, if you identify yourself as a visitor to the UTHSC campus. If you need a **FREE** place to stay while interviewing for medical school, we invite you to utilize our Prospective Student Lodging Program to accommodate temporary lodging the night before your interview and the opportunity for you to stay with current medical students.
