

Aural Habilitation Concentration (AHC)

Process

- I. Complete the attached AHC application form and submit to a Child Hearing Services (CHS) Representative and to the Departmental Administrative Specialist. Sign the Statement of Participation on the application form. The AHC application form should include your Academic Advisor's signature. Your application should be submitted during the last three weeks of the second semester (Spring), or during the last three weeks of Summer term.
- II. Attach a Written Statement of Purpose and Description of Experiences to the application form.
- III. Attach a photocopy of your transcript and 2 written recommendations from both academic and clinical faculty to the application form. These will indicate completion of one semester of practicum in Child Hearing Services (CHS) and good academic standing and potential.
- IV. You will then receive notification of acceptance/rejection from the AHC committee which consists of CHS Representatives. Letters will be sent during the week following completion of the Semester/Term. Notify your Academic Advisor of your status. The number of students accepted will vary depending on the CHS caseload and clinical faculty responsibilities.
- V. At the end of each semester: complete and submit the following to a CHS Representative: 1) your class schedule for the upcoming semester; 2) your Documentation of Completion per Semester form.
- VI. Completion of all AHC requirements must be verified by approval signatures from your Academic Advisor and a CHS Representative on the ASP 12 form (Program of Clinical Practicum) and on the AHC Completion form.
- VII. An Aural Habilitation Concentration Certificate will be awarded following completion of requirements.
