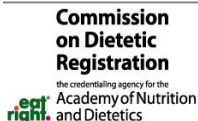
SOCIAL WORK & PHYSICAL THERAPY

Purpose

The Interdisciplinary Community Education (ICE) seminars present topics addressing medical and behavioral issues for children with special health care needs and adults with neurodevelopmental and related disabilities across the life span. Sessions focus on current and future directions in family-centered care, intervention approaches for diverse populations, and collaboration at the local, state, and national levels.

Who Should Attend

Healthcare professionals, direct support staff, family members, and persons who share an interest in learning more about intellectual disabilities/developmental disabilities and children with special health care needs are invited to attend.

Availability on the Web

ICE sessions will be available through web conferencing for up to 5 sites for each seminar. A site is defined as a host location that can accommodate a minimum of five attendees. Webcasting is reserved for site participation only and will not be available to individual users at this time.

Interested sites must register at least ten days in advance of any session to allow for testing and technical assistance. Eligible sites will need a high speed internet connection, speaker phone, and an LCD projector. A web camera is not required. If participant sites have a web camera attached to the computer, this item can be tested prior to the seminar.
