Recipients of the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship who have lost the scholarship due to their HOPE GPA have two options to regain eligibility. The scholarship can be regained only <b>one</b> (1) time during the student's entire college career regardless if student remains at the same school or transfers. Students may regain eligibility at the next HOPE attempted hour checkpoint following the original loss of the award. You will be notified within <a href="two weeks">two weeks</a> regarding your appeal.							
Students who have forfeited the scholarship due to withdrawal or dropping below full time status without prior approval from the financial aid office <b>do not</b> qualify to regain under these options. Students who originally received HOPE Merit (GAMS) will regain HOPE only.							
A valid FAFSA must be on file in the Financial Aid Office before submitting this form.							
<ul> <li>At the 24 and 48 total attempted hour check points, the student must have a 2.75 or above cumulative HOPE GPA. At every check point thereafter (72, 96, 120, etc) the student will be able to retain the award in one of two ways:</li> <li>Maintain a cumulative HOPE GPA of 3.0 or above (traditional method). Eligibility will be reviewed at the next 24 hours attempted;</li> <li>Maintain a cumulative HOPE GPA of 2.75 – 2.99 and 3.0 semester GPA (provisional method). Students regaining the scholarship under the provisional method must be enrolled full time. Eligibility will be reviewed at the end of each semester.</li> </ul>							
Please check the option you would like for UTHSC to consider:							
Option #1 – Repeat Course: The student may repeat one course and the highest grade shall be applied for the HOPE GPA consideration. The HOPE GPA originally included ALL grades and attempted hours after high school graduation. This option will eliminate only one low grade attempting to increase the cumulative HOPE GPA to meet requirements. This option can be used at the end of the 24 hour check point only if class has already been repeated.  * If you choose this option, please provide repeat course information below.
