IRS DRT - Unavailable!

The IRS DRT on fafsa.gov is currently unavailable. Applicants filling out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) can manually enter the requested financial information from copies of their tax returns.

Additional information:

The online FAFSA remains operational, and families can continue filling the FAFSA as you normally would, using your 2015 tax information.

The income information needed to complete the FAFSA can be found on your tax return. If you did not retain a copy of your tax return, you may be able to access the tax software you used to prepare your return or contact your tax preparer to obtain a copy.

If you are unable to get a copy of your tax return, you may visit www.irs.gov/transcript to view and download a summary of your tax return, called a tax transcript, at Get Transcript Online. You must verify your identity to use this tool. You also may use **Get Transcript** by Mail or call 1-800-908-9946, and a transcript will be delivered to your address of record within five to 10 days.
