#### STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT DATA

Each of the professional programs offered at UTHSC pursues the mission of the institution by producing caring, competent, and ethical patient-focused healthcare professionals prepared to detect, treat, and prevent human disease and injury. The expectation is that every student in each professional program will pass the professional licensure examination at or near completion of the program.

UTHSC measures student achievement in two primary ways: first-time pass rates on professional licensure exams, and graduation rates for graduate/professional programs and for undergraduate programs.

UTHSC calculates two graduation rates – one for graduate/professional programs and one for undergraduate programs. Readers should note that UTHSC does not offer lower division undergraduate courses; undergraduate programs offered by UTHSC are completion programs. Therefore, the graduation rates are not calculated according to the IPEDS definition. However, the calculations are very similar to the IPEDS method and the calculations are uniform from year to year.

The graduation rate calculation is based on the entering cohort into each program, and the number of students from that cohort who graduate within 1.5 times the nominal time to degree for that program. For example, the DDS program is a nominal 4-year program and thus the number of students in an entering cohort who have graduated within 6 years of entry is used. Undergraduate programs at UTHSC are typically 1-year programs, so the number of students in the entering cohort who have graduated within 1.5 years (3 terms) is used.

UTHSC strives for graduation rates above 90%, but the *threshold of acceptability* is set at 90% for graduate/professional programs and 85% for undergraduate programs. These thresholds were approved by the Committee on Academic and Student Affairs (CASA) after reviewing what other academic health science centers had set.
