Dr. McCall received his BA from Baylor University, an MA in Cultural Anthropology from Southern Methodist University (Dallas) and PhD in Sociology of the Family from University of North Texas in Denton, Texas.

He is a native of Memphis and is married to his wife, Sharon, and has three married children and eight grandchildren.

He retired from UTHSC as an Associate Professor in Family Medicine, serving 30 years in various administrative roles and teaching positions, specializing in providing international educational partnerships for the medical students.

In 1992, Dr. McCall founded the Arkwings Foundation and Center located at 2034 James Rd., Memphis, 38111, a center and foundation providing facilities and programming to promote integrated health and wellness with a focus on inner city youth and their families. He continues to serve as board chair of this foundation.
