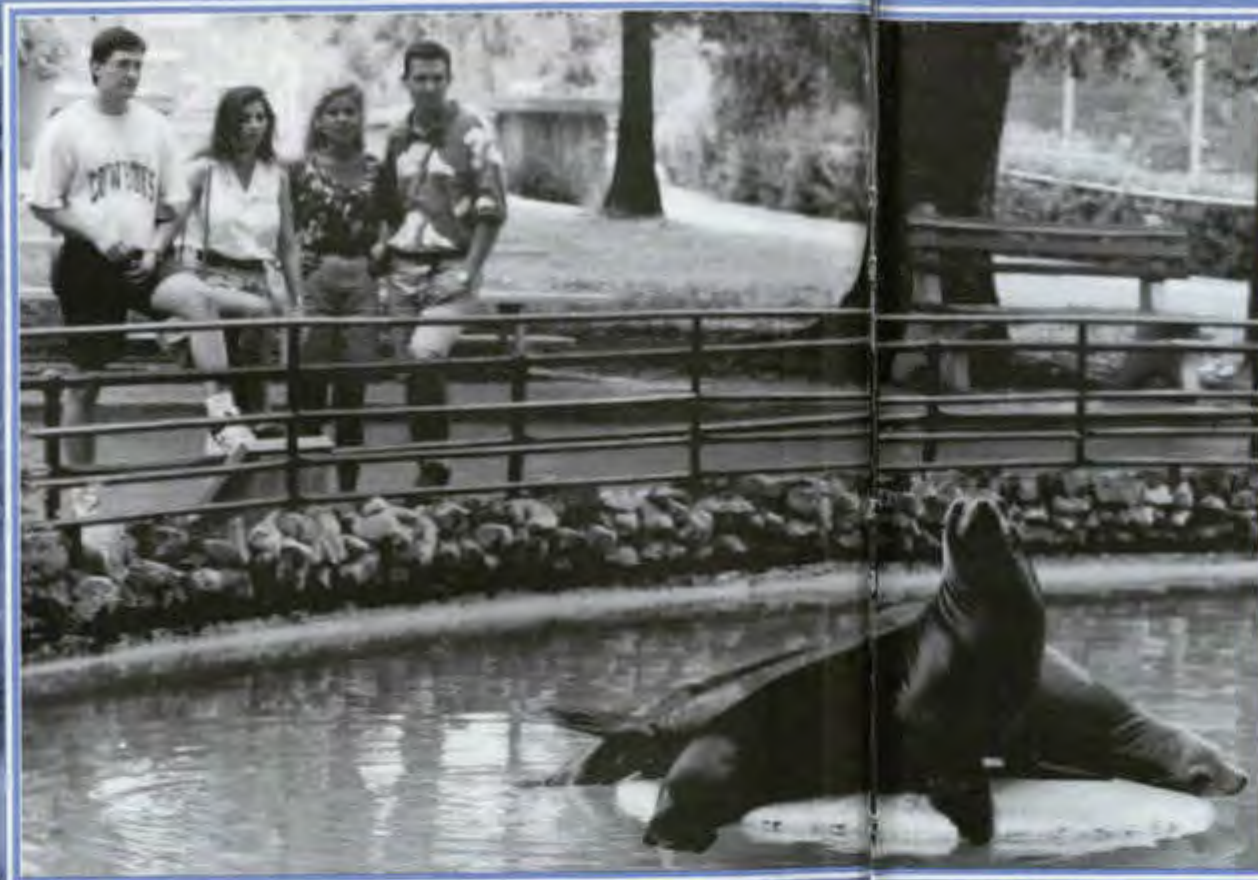

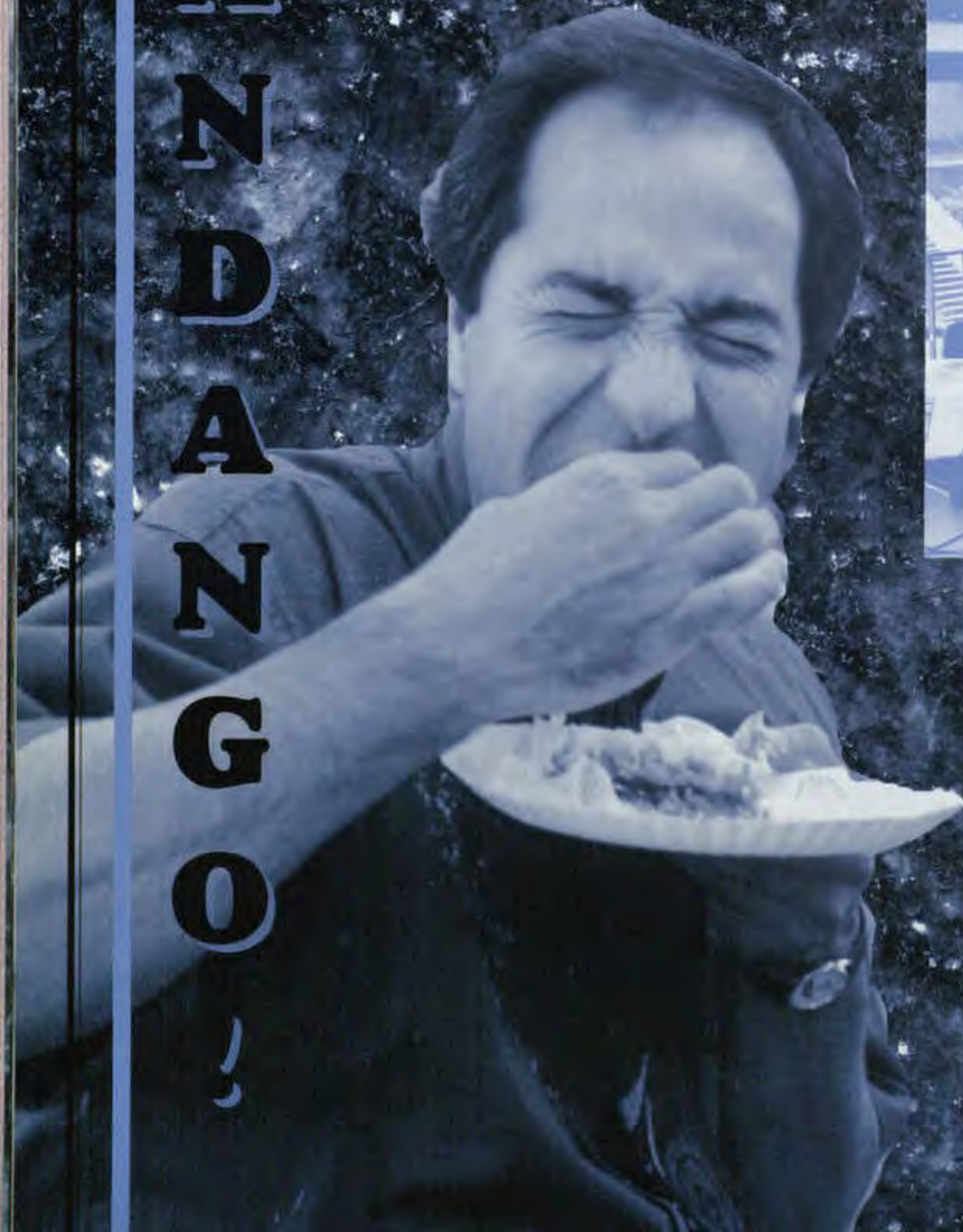

The Student Government Association Executive Council, which serves as the official voice of students at the University of Tennessee, Memphis, works closely with faculty, administration, and staff to ensure that students' needs are met.

The 1994-95 SGAEC began by addressing common concerns such as safety, tuition, and overall student satisfaction. Our primary concern was safety. The council felt that Goodman Residence Hall needed improvements. We met staff from Housing and expressed our concerns to Chancellor Rice. These important concerns were heard and vast improvements were accomplished that make Goodman a much safer temporary home for our students.

A major part of our success was the open line of communication that we established and maintained with our faculty and administration. Monthly meetings were held with the Chancellor and weekly meetings were held with Student Affairs. Through such communication, we were able to revise the nomination process for the Excellence In Teaching Awards. The Faculty Senate was very supportive of the students involvement in this process. The SGAEC also co-sponsored many entertainment events such as Luau, Neo Gio, and Springfest.

We continued with our active participation in issues concerning tuition increases. The Government Affairs Committee met with Tennessee Higher Education Commission members, lobbyists, and legislators. We would like to thank Bill Robinson and Pam Moon for their genuine support of students. The success of the year would not have been possible without their unlimited dedication.

Asklepieion is a word derived from the name Aesculapius, the Greek god of medicine and healing. Aesculapius was honored and worshipped throughout the Greek world by persons seeking the healing powers of the physician. Temples were erected in honor of Aesculapius near healing springs or high mountains. Those who worshipped him were known as Aesculapae. Therefore, the temples in his honor were known as Aesculapions (Asklepieions). In the ancient city of Memphis, on the Nile River, there was a temple where persons went for worship and care. In our own city of Memphis, on the Mississippi River, people come to our Asklepieion for healing and care.

The central administration of the University of Tennessee-headed by the president of the University, who is directly accountable to the Board of Trustees- has general responsibility for the overall operation of the University.

The Board of Trustees, the University's governing body, consists of five ex-officio members (the Governor of Tennessee, the President of the University, the Commissioner of Education, the Commissioner of Agriculture the Executive Director of the Tennessee Higher Education Commission), and nineteen additional appointed members, including one student.

Its purpose is to establish policies controlling the scope of the educational opportunities to be offered by the University as well as policies determining its operation in general. The Board has full authority to determine and to control the activities and policies of all organization that bear the name of the University. It also controls the election, appointment and removal of all the officers, faculty, and employees of the University.

Bon Voyage

Bound for Destinations Unknown

When Dr. Dick Gourley came to the University of Tennessee as Dean of the College of Pharmacy in 1990, he had a grand vision. Among one of his many plans for the college was to implement an international student exchange program.

Utilizing contacts cultivated over his 25 years in the profession, Dean Gourley proposed a one month externship during the fourth year rotations in a number of cities around the world. The first students to participate in the program graduated in 1991.

The program expanded to 10 cities in eight countries. The College of Pharmacy provides a travel grant to help defer costs of traveling to such locales as New Zealand, Sweden, Holland and Denmark. Housing is provided by the host site.

In 1995, a site in Holland had its first UT students. Twenty students traveled abroad the month of April and spent a month. Many had the chance to travel during their month off in May. This program served to broaden the horizons of its students.

The many differences, cultural as well as professional, were overcome with little trouble. The number one choice of students was Australia. Students who chose Japan reported the most "food shock" and the most trouble with language. Barcelona, Spain is the only host requiring proficiency of a language other than English. New Zealand was the only country thus far to extend the program to a true exchange by sending a student to the United States. Though, other countries have sent professionals instead of students.
