- Met our target for Jan25, will end the year on a balance budget.
- All feedback has been sent to the central DASH leadership team. A plan of correction invoking short term, intermediate, and long-term changes is being rolled out. UT System leadership is committed to getting all issues resolved.

Updates on Federal-State Executive Orders and legal situations – (Raaj and Jessica):

- Still monitoring: Research stopping grants, indirect cost rates, new notices coming out slower than usual. Jessica Snowden and research office meeting with colleges and researchers. Contingency Planning Group meets every 2 weeks to assess situations and recommend strategies to more quickly address the rapidly changing environment.
- Planning- money not used during the grant award period will no longer be available.
- New bill- "One Big Beautiful Bill" is being passed down through the Senate, waiting on the outcome.
