

Scholarship Application for Visiting Under-represented in Medicine Fourth Year Medical Students

The University of Tennessee College of Medicine Chattanooga **Department of Pediatrics** strives to recruit and retain trainees that reflect the diversity represented in our patients and faculty. We believe that having physicians that reflect the population that we serve results in better healthcare outcomes. The Department offers multiple scholarships **(up to \$1,500 each, reimbursement for housing, travel and meals)** for visiting URiM fourth year medical students taking part in a 4-week General Pediatric or Pediatric subspecialty rotation at our academic institution.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be in good standing and enrolled in their fourth or final year of an MD or DO degree program at an
 accredited Liaison Committee on Medical Education or Education Department of the American Osteopathic
 Association medical school during their elective rotation
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent resident
- Students must self-identify as under-represented in medicine (URiM): Black (African/African American),
 Latino/Hispanic (Mexican American, Cuban, Puerto Rican, Central American, South American),
 Native American with tribal affiliation,
 Native Hawaiian,
 Pacific Islander,
 LGBTQ+

- Direct one-on-one mentoring with URiM pediatric faculty
- Meeting with residency Program Leadership
- Invitation to participate in residency events held during the scheduled rotation
- Continued longitudinal mentorship opportunities throughout the academic year
- Participation in Pediatrics DEI Council meetings and events

 - Attach 1 letter of recommendation from an individual (not family related) or faculty member who can relate personal experience with your clinical work and/or personal story.
- Consideration for any scholarship award will be based on holistic review taking into consideration your CV & personal statement, supporting letter of recommendation, as well as your application in VSLO.
