

Policy On Recording Lectures

1. Consistent with AA119-H, students currently enrolled in College of Dentistry courses may only have access to lecture recordings that are recorded on UT Health Science Center/GEB equipment and subsequently posted to a secure Blackboard site managed by the College of Dentistry Ed Tech Specialist
2. Consistent with AA119-H, re-use of recordings (students previously enrolled, tutors, other faculty, etc.) requires approval of the instructor of record, and/or lecturers of record.
3. Students MAY NOT record lectures on any personal device, unless express written permission is given in the course syllabus.
4. Under no circumstance may students post lectures on any social media or distribute lecture recordings in any form.
5. Consistent with AA119-H, violations of this policy are considered violations of the UT Health Science Center Honor Code. Students may be subject to additional penalties, including possible dismissal, as the College of Dentistry deems appropriate.
6. The College of Dentistry mandatory attendance/excused absence policy is still in force.
7. Course directors and/or lecturers may choose not to have recorded lectures made available to students.
