Chancellor Schwab:

1. U.S. News & World Report – College of Pharmacy ranks 17th and Nursing DNP program ranks 24th in the country.
2. Newly accredited Anesthesiology Residency program
3. Expansion of programs in the College of Dentistry across state, unserved and underserved areas
4. Requesting State increase GME funds
5. Increased collaboration with ORNL
6. Peg Hartig introduced as UTHSC Faculty Senate President

Assistant Vice-Chancellor Michael Alston:

Waiting for new Title IX regs on sexual harassment

Vice-Chancellor Ferrara:

1. Working to obtain state support for UTHSC “operation funds”. Funds for lights, gas, etc. Have not received in the past
2. Top 10 safest campuses

Dean of Nursing Wendy Likes:

College of Nursing Report –

1. Number one school in Tennessee for the most DNP graduates,
2. Number one for colleges of nursing in the state of Tennessee for NIH funding
3. Development of Center for Community and Global Partnerships
4. Transition of its accelerated BSN program to a 12-month program.

Vice-Chancellor Gonzalez:

1. Described the strategic plan as a “living document”, continuously updated.
2. Progress on SACS accreditation
3. Priorities include education, research, clinical care, visibility and recognition, and resource alignment
