Recruit, Educate, and Graduate Successful Scientists and Research Professionals

Develop Collaboration, Teamwork, and Conflict Management Skills to Enhance Employability

- Assess participation in short workshops and team activities that build skills
- Assess progress from aggregate scores by faculty of “Communication skills” and “Teamwork skills” categories on annual progress reports
- Number of students applying for and obtaining sabbaticals/internships outside of UTHSC
- Measure employment rates post-graduation

Provide Research Experiences that Enhance Recruitment:

- Track recruitment rates for each type of research experience offered
- Survey participants about their research experience

Ensure Adequate Stipend Support for GRAs:

- Monitor stipend levels compared to cost of living and peer institutions
- Project three-year expenditures vs. targeted enrollment growth

Adapt Course Offerings for Emerging Tech:

- Evaluate the inclusion of emerging tech topics in curriculum
- Measure student enrollment in these courses

Increase Participation in Dual-Degree and Micro-Credential Programs:

- Assess the awareness of the UTHSC student body about these programs
- Measure the number of students enrolled in dual-degree and micro-credential programs

Enhance the Impact of Research

Promote Entrepreneurship Opportunities for Trainees and Faculty:

- Number of entrepreneurship workshops conducted
- Number of participants in entrepreneurship programs or courses

Increase Trainee Presentation at Local, National, and International Venues:

- Number of trainee presentations assessed by venue
- Number of travel awards granted

Increase Collaboration Opportunities:

- Number of collaborative projects initiated by trainees as assessed in annual progress reports
- Number of institutions or organizations involved in research collaborations
- Number of students applying for and obtaining sabbaticals/internships outside of UTHSC

Increase Community Awareness of CGHS Research:

- Number of community outreach events, particularly with nearby schools, colleges, and universities
- Number of media mentions or publications

Encourage the Development of Independent Projects by Trainees:

- Number of independent projects by trainees that are supported with intramural and extramural funding
- Application and success rate of trainees' independent projects

Develop Productive and Effective Faculty and Post-Docs

Foster and Reward Excellence in Teaching and Mentoring:

- Number of teaching and mentoring awards given
- Number of faculty participating in teaching and mentoring programs

Provide Instruction in Best Practices in Mentoring:

- Number of participants in mentoring workshops and boot-camp
- Feedback scores from mentoring workshop participants

Develop Grantsmanship through Collaboration with Research Admin:

- Number of grants submitted through by trainees
- Amount of funding received from grants

Foster Interprofessional and Interdisciplinary Collaboration across Diverse Programs:

- Number of interprofessional and interdisciplinary activities
- Faculty Committee participation outside of their institution or program
- Number of students applying for and obtaining sabbaticals/internships outside of UTHSC

Enhance the Postdoc Applicant Pool:

- Number of postdoc applicants responding to position advertisements
- Quality of postdoc applicants measured by their credentials

Ensure Sufficient Resources to Meet Strategic Priorities

Actively Engage in UTHSC Faculty Recruitment:

- Number of potential faculty contacted
- If faculty opt to leave UTHSC ensure that any students they may have recruited are continuously supported
- List connections between faculty and alumni

Engage UTHSC Development and Alumni Offices:

- Number of engagement events with development and alumni offices
- Number of alumni actively participating in office initiatives

Secure Institutional, Extramural Investment to Support Enrollment Growth:

- Amount of institutional investment secured relative to enrollment growth
- Amount of extramural investment secured relative to enrollment growth

Secure Institutional, Extramural Investment to Support Strategic Initiatives:

- Amount of investment allocated to strategic initiatives
- Number of strategic initiatives supported by the investment
