Educational Assistance Frequently Asked Questions

- What fees does UT pay?
 - The **TBR Fee Waiver** covers the per credit hour maintenance fees only.
 - The **P130** will cover maintenance fees, registration fees, technology access fees, online course fees, TN eCampus (formerly RODP) fees and service charges.
- What school can I attend?
 - You can attend any UT or approved Tennessee Board of Regents School.
 - List of Eligible Institutions.
- Can I attend more than one university?
 - You can attend more than one university up to your eligible amount of credit hours.
- Where do I get the forms?
 - You can print the forms from the **Educational Assistance** webpage.
- Who signs my Educational Assistance Forms?
 - The P130, TBR Fee Waiver and Spouse Dependent forms require the employee and supervisor signatures prior to HR approval.
 - The UTHSC form requires the employee signature, at least two departmental signatures prior to HR approval.
- What should I do if I change a course(s) after submitting forms to my school?
 - If you change courses, add or drop courses after HR approval, you must update the Benefits office as well as your school's Bursar or Registrar's office.
- What happens if I leave UT before I complete the course(s)?
 - You will be required to reimburse UT for the cost of courses listed on the TBR FeeWaiver. The P130 does not require reimbursement.
- What happens if I drop or fail a course?
 - If you drop a course after the full refund date or fail a course on the TBR Fee Waiver, you will be required to reimburse UT. No reimbursement required for the P130.
- How do I reimburse UT?
 - You can repay via payroll deductions or arrange to pay in a lump sum with a money order.
- Who is responsible for getting my forms to my school?
 - It is the employee or employee's dependent's responsibility to ensure their forms are forwarded to their institution.
- Can I receive HR 128 Credit for TBR Courses?
 - Yes, courses can be used for HR 128 credits.
- What if I change departments while using Educational Assistance?
 - The department you are in when the semester begins is responsible for the fees.
