RESPONSIBILITIES

Data:

- Provide research data lifecycle support to faculty, students, and staff through
 consultations and virtual reference services. Assist researchers in locating external
 datasets, complying with funder mandates (e.g. 2023 NIH Data Sharing Policy), creating
 data management plans, and identifying local experts.
- Work in close collaboration with the Research Data and Scholarly Communications Lead to support UTHSC researchers in the areas of citation analysis, research impact metrics and benchmarking, and data visualization.
- Provide technical expertise for Library special projects.
- Collaborate with others in the Library to develop and promote robust and cohesive research data services; help train Library colleagues to handle basic research data management inquiries.
- Develop and lead instructional programming on data-related topics and tools.

Assessment:

- Collaborate with Library administration to design and implement quantitative and qualitative library assessments to identify user needs, demonstrate library impact, improve services, and inform decision-making related to the UTHSC Library strategic plan.
- Assist with collecting statistics and preparing reports for various accreditating organizations, such as AAHSL, ARL, IPEDS, etc.
- In partnership with other Library units, lead the creation of visualizations and strategies intended to communicate Library data, assessment results, and other related information to guide strategic decision making.
- Develop and maintain ongoing processes and tools for the collection, storage, and analysis of Library data.

General:

- Participate in the development, implementation, and evaluation of Library services, policies, and procedures.
- Assist in Research and Learning Service (RLS) activities as needed, including: liaison duties, database searching, reference consultation, etc.
- Participate in professional activities and professional development.
- Develop and maintain appropriate Library LibGuides.
- Manage or assist with special projects.

QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum Requirements:

- Accredited graduate degree in an appropriate discipline such as Library and Information Science, Data Science, or related area (degree must be awarded prior to start date).
- Strong analytical skills and experience with statistical analysis and research.
- Knowledge of technology tools, including mobile devices and web applications.
- Ability to manipulate and transform data from one format/type to another.
- Excellent interpersonal, written, and oral communication skills.

• Demonstrated ability to work independently and collaboratively in a team environment with a strong service orientation.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Demonstrable experience with one or more programming languages (e.g. Python, R, SQL).
- Familiarity with current best practices and trends in the research data lifecycle.
- Experience with Digital Commons (https://www.bepress.com/products/digital-commons/) or other institutional repository system.
- Experience with LibInsight (https://springshare.com/libinsight/) or another library statistics platform.
- Bachelor's degree in a science discipline.
- Familiarity with medical vocabulary and evidence-based practice.
- Teaching experience.
- Preference will be given to candidates with a background in or an enthusiasm for the health or life sciences.

BENEFITS

University faculty appointment: This is a 12-month, full-time, non-tenure track faculty appointment. Faculty rank will be at the level of Assistant Professor.

Salary is commensurate with education/experience. \$60,000 minimum for the candidate with the required education and experience.
