

THE ASKLEPIEION THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE **MEMPHIS** Asklepieion: a word derived from the name of Aesculapius, the Greek god of medicine and healing. Aesculapius was honored and worshipped throughout the Greek world by persons seeking the healing powers of the physician. Temples were erected in honor of Aesculapius near healing springs or on high mountains. Those who worshipped him were known as Aesculapae, therefore, the temples in his honor were known as the Aesculapions (Asklepieions): In the ancient city of Memphis, on the Nile River, there was a temple where persons went for worship and for care. In our own city of Memphis, on the Mississippi River, people come to our Asklepieion for healing and care. — Bill Robinson, Associate Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs

elta Sigma Delta was established by far-sighted professionals — men with vision — who possessed the desire to render the best dental services in the highest professional manner. IN MEMORY OF DR. JAMES ANDREWS, D.D.S. 1921-1987



Dr. James T. Andrews died on July 8, 1987 after 35 years of dedicated and exemplary service to the UT College of Dentistry. He was involved in several academic areas during his earlier years in dental education, but he was best known by students, fellow teachers, and dental educators nationwide for his many years as professor and chairman of operative dentistry, the position held at the time of his death. Dr. Andrews was recognized as an institution in the College of Dentistry.

Dr. Andrews graduated with honors from the UT College of Dentistry in 1952 and immediately became a full-time faculty member in operative dentistry and pedodontics. Since he had been an officer in the U.S. Marine Corps and a college football coach before going to dental school, he was a mature dental student who, upon graduation, entered into a professional career with an air of maturity, stability, and professional bearing that most young teachers have to grow into over the years. His leadership qualities were soon recognized and he began early receiving and efficiently handling administrative assignments along with his teaching duties. After three years of a dual role in operative dentistry and pedodontics, he became acting chief of the division of operative dentistry in 1955. A year later he was appointed chief of the division of operative dentistry. He was an excellent administrator and an outstanding teacher throughout his career.

"Jim left his mark on every graduating student and will be sorely missed as an educator and a gentleman," said Dean William F. Slagle. "With the passing of Jim Andrews, the university has lost one of its finest teachers and the faculty has lost a most respected colleague."

A New Beginning

If it could be said that the UT Memphis Graduate School had one banner year, it would have to have been 1987-88. Things changed at the fastest rate in the institution's 65year history.

- ** The School became a College. After an exceptionally long puberty, the graduate school matured in status and name to become the College of Graduate Health Sciences.
- ** The university administration's commitment to propel UT Memphis into the forefront of the nation's research universities was assisted by increasing the emphasis put on the biomedical sciences. This move was helped, in part, by the chairs of excellence program. Graduate students are involved in the majority of laboratories sponsored by these exceptional scientists.
- ** For the first time since 1979, a new dean took the captain's chair to steer the graduate study programs. Dr. Raymond Cypess arrived in January to take the reins of the new college and propel it into the future. As a microbiologist, epidemiologist and veterinarian, Cypess brought from Cornell University a broad list of qualifications with which to lead the college.
- ** And finally the students. The number of doctoral and master's degree research students has grown significantly in the last few years. These are the scientists of the future. Cypess has vowed to expand the graduate student program and make it more visible in the university community.

The goals set by Cypess for the college are simple:

- * Recruit the best faculty
- * Recruit the best students
- * Establish an operational and intellectual environment that enhances and provides research and research training.

A tall order but ultimately, a successful one.
