




Asklepieion: a word derived from the name of Aesculapius, the Greek god of medicine and healing. Aesculapius was honored and worshipped throughout the Greek world by persons seeking the healing powers of the physician. Temples were erected in honor of Aesculapius near healing springs or high mountains. Those who worshipped him were known as Aesculapiae, therefore, the temples in his honor were known as the Aesculapions (Asklepieions). In the ancient city of Memphis, on the Nile River, there was a temple where persons went for worship and to care. In our own city of Memphis, on the Mississippi River, people come to our Asklepieion for healing and care. — Bill Robinson, Associate Vice Chancelor, Student Affairs-Pictured above is the Sanctuary of Asklepious in Epidavros, Greece. # With fond memories of Tony



### ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE BEDRAIL by Tony Ficalora, '88

I was recently approached to write an article about my thoughts and feelings about my "recent bout with leukemia." At first I rejected it soundly — I fligured an article and a few well-placed tears and I was a shoo-in for martyr of the year. I'm also not one for baring my soul — I rarely open up — so why should I let It all out for everyone at UT. Well, I said no, and then was asked to think about it more because it really would help people out "We're not trained to be compassionate in med school or our residencies." Which is true, I guess — I mean there is no human compassion and feelings of course. There's also no "How to Appreciate Your Life" class offered either.

O.K., just a little stick. How many times have you said that? It's practically reflex, you say it almost unconsciously. Well, I've got news, folks — It's not just a little stick. It hurts. It really does. It hurts when you get one every day or several at once. So should we stop ordering blood cultures and lab work? No, but maybe we can stop and think about what our patients are going through. And how we can show them a more carrier attitude.

how we can show them a more caring attitude.

O.K. class, today we learn about life. Do you appreciate it? Do you really? Have you thought about dying? Poof — you are dead — you are gone. You can't talk to anyone anymore. You are gone, they will go on living their lives — they'll be sad for a while but then their old routines will kick back in and they'll live out the rest of their lives, without you. You're dead. You can't smell pizza or your cologne or cinnamon or anything. You can't enjoy that weather anymore. Not just the warm sunshine and blue skles but the rain and the lightning and the humidity and the crappy weather averything. Man — it's all gone. No more ice cream. You'll never have kids. You'll never get married. You'll never have grand-children. How much have you thought about taking your grand-

children. How much have you thought about taking your grand-children fishing? Or buying them a kite or just visiting them?

All your friends and family — are you happy with the way you left them? You're gone — everything is unchangeable now. Can you honestly say that if you died at this instance you'd be happy with the way they think of you? Of all the things that were unsettled and unsaid? All that petty trash that we love to thrive on.

O.K., so what's my point? All I'm saying is the old cliche "Live each day like it's your last." I know it sounds like it's off of a cutesy poster with fuzzy kittens and Smurfs, but it's actually a wise statement. It took a catastrophe to make me realize how serious the whole deal is. So now I look at the colors, and I notice the smells. I'm thankful that I can walk, and I'm thankful I can taste chocolate, and I'm thankful for my family and my friends. I really hope the same goes for you.

Anthony S. Ficalora, known by most as simply "Tony," was an extraordinary young man of courage and generosity. He shared of his very self with us as he struggled with cancer (Acute Lymphocytic Leukemia), and taught us much in the process. To start with, he wrote "On the Other Side of the Bedrail" for UT's medical student newspaper, The Auricle, in spite of his initial misgivings. He was afraid at first that if he wrote the article concerning his feelings as he dealt with his disease, as his friend Edd Thomas (the then-editor) had requested, that people would pity him. This fear is human nature — I suppose most of us would have left the same way. But Tony transcended his feeling and did write the article, allowing his fellow physicians-intraining to learn, through his eyes, about what it's like to have a terminal illness, about compassion, and about appreciating life.

Tony also gave by allowing us to give. The old saying that "It is in giving that we receive" really is true. By his accepting our concern for him so gracefully and not withdrawing, we were encouraged to do more. The UT community worked together in fund-raising for the bone marrow transplant, and the greeting-card type video for him, and shared a common concern as we rallied around Tony, which elevated us above the common, sometimes self-centered, everyday grind.

Not only by the words he wrote, but by his actions as well, did Tony teach us. He showed courage and determination in his fight for life, grace and dignity when it was clearly time to accept the inevitable. Stricken with leukemia in his M-3 year, he decided not to stop his studies. He continued his coursework while undergoing treatment, and remarkably, kept up with his class. Then in May, 1988, a relapse (not the first) caused him to fall behind 16 credit hours. However, he was allowed to graduate with his class (in absentia), and was voted by his fellow students in the class of '88 as the recipient of the Charles Verstandig award, which goes to the stu-dent who overcomes the most obstacles to obtaining his medical career. After his September bone marrow transplant, Tony relapsed again in early January 1989. Advised by his doctors that further chemotherapy would be fruitless, he opted to remain at home with loved ones. He died peacefully the evening of February the 18th, in his own room, with his parerits and two of his four brothers and sisters present. Two days before he died, he learned that the 16 credit hours he needed had been waived, as officials of the school felt that his almost two year experience with his disease compensated for these hours both educationally and professionally, and the awarding of his M.D. was official as of December 9, 1988.

Although Anthony Ficalora never glot to go out and practice medicine with the M.D. he worked so hard to obtain, his life was not in vain. He left a legacy — not only the students of the five classes who experienced his tragedy with him, but also the generations of medical students who will be influenced by the award and scholarship established in his name. His lessons of compassion and appreciating life will live on in us as we scatter after our own graduations to take care of patients and help their families. Tony will be missed, but not forgotten.


