





Asklepieion is a word derived from the name of Aesculapius, the Greek

god of medicine and healing. Aesculapius was honored and worshipped throughout the Greek world by persons seeking the healing powers of the physician. Temples were erected in honor of




In the ancient city of Memphis, on the Nile River, there was a temple where people went for worship and for care. In our own city of Memphis,































# Redbirds Night





Each year the Student Government Association Executive Council (SGAEC) presents its Excellence in Teaching Awards at the Spring Banquet.


