#### **GENERAL TOUR PROCEDURES**

Provide a general introduction to the entire group and if necessary, break into small groups. Encourage prospective students to introduce themselves, by name, hometown and academic area of interest and to ask LOTS of questions. Make sure your tour is no longer than the desired time and keep in mind an interviewee may be scheduled to interview as early as 1:30 p.m. Returning tour guide volunteers can be an excellent mentor for a first time volunteer, e.g., current M3 and M4.

Typically, the GEB tour will begin in the lobby of the GEB at 11:15 a.m. and end in the Medicine Admissions Conference Room. The clinical tour will begin at 12:30 p.m. and end in the Medicine Admissions Conference Room. We would prefer that you personalize the process and portray the medical school and the Memphis community in an honest and positive way.

Please feel free to provide the interviewees with your contact information and ask if there are additional questions. However, never fabricate an answer and refer ALL admissions inquires to the COM Admissions staff. Don't be afraid to let the interviewees know you will find someone to help them with any questions that are not answered when the tour has concluded.

Take a few minutes, if possible, to plan how the tour will run. It is your goal as a tour guide to show prospective students what The UT Health Science Center College of Medicine has to offer. **Your appearance should be professional.** Remember to wear comfortable walking shoes and your identification name badge. You will be e-mailed a reminder when you will be scheduled to conduct the tour.

#### **TOUR GUIDE PROGRAM**

The Tour Guide Program is one of the most important volunteer activities you can participate in to assist the Admissions Office in the recruitment of future medical students. #### **CAMPUS TOURS**

Within the Tour Guide Program, there are two (2) types of tours: (1) tour of the educational facilities by M2's and (2) tour of the clinical facilities by M3's and M4's. M2 volunteers are expected to provide a guided 45-minute tour of the GEB, pointing out SASSI, the lecture halls, mailboxes, bulletin boards, lockers, the library, independent study areas, Gross Anatomy lab, Clinical Skills Center, as well as, convey a general sense of an average day of a medical student. The College of Medicine will interview applicants on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays, beginning **Monday**, **October 2** and ending around the end of April. The schedule will typically indicate the names of two M2 students, one M3 and M4 student. Depending on the number of applicants interviewing, more or less volunteers will be needed. The schedule will be e-mailed one to two weeks in advance. If you are unable to conduct your scheduled tour, it is your responsibility to find a replacement by asking a fellow student. Once you have found a replacement, e-mail or text Diane Harris, admissions coordinator, with any changes.
