Vacation block equals 3 weeks of vacation and 1 week of academic leave

Curriculum requirements:

32 weeks = 8 Blocks for **core pediatric hospital medicine skills**

32 weeks = 8 Blocks for **Individualized Curriculum (IC) blocks/units.**

Fellows develop Individualized Curriculum through 8 blocks of electives.

Each IC block will be divided into 0.5 units (2 weeks)

IC blocks consist of either Clinical or Non-Clinical

Choice of electives are made in collaboration with advisor and program directors.

Fellows can have a maximum of 2 non-Clinical elective blocks each PGY year (unless permission by program director).

For Clinical electives:

1. Inpatient Teaching Service
2. Non-teaching Attending Only service*
3. Infectious Disease
4. Palliative Care
5. Child Abuse
6. St Jude Hematology/Oncology**
7. Infectious Disease, Palliative Care, or Child Abuse.
8. NICU (ROH or Le Bonheur)

*Non-Teaching Attending Only Service will be encouraged

**St Jude Hematology/Oncology during PGY5 is a full block and permission by the program director will be needed to replace this elective.

For Non-Clinical Electives:

1. Research
2. Advocacy / Medical Legal Partnership (1 unit),
3. Leadership / Management (0.5)

32 weeks = 8 Blocks for **Research Curriculum**
